



Leslie Bartlett lecture at RAA

The Rockport Art Association will host “Arrive, To Look,” a lecture by photographer Leslie D. Bartlett on Wednesday, July 8 at 7:30 p.m. Free and open to the public.

Bartlett is known for his quarry photographs and ability to capture light and its most incandescent and fleeting qualities in nature. The lecture will last for 45 minutes with time for questions at the end. Bartlett will cover how his early life prepared him for an appreciation of the horizon, how the stage magic, light and juggling at the Cabot Street Theatre imbued him with immediate light in imagery.

He will discuss the art of waiting in the stone quarries of Cape Ann and Barre, VT. and how the wait it has deepened his art. He will also share from his latest project - *‘Give Me Your Hands, The Barre Sculptors and Their Stone.’*

This event will be in conjecture with Bartlett’s outdoor photo quarry workshop the following day. The lecture will be followed by a wine and cheese reception.
